In this lecture will be shown that the unique nature of the insurance contract led to the development and application of specific duties of disclosure on the insured and on the insurer. The object of these duties is to abridge the information gap on the one hand, and to protect the insured against the powerful insurer on the other hand. These duties are imposed on the parties to the insurance contract both in pre-contractual phase, and after its conclusion. A comparative report prepared based on six questions, answered by 28 countries shows differences in the scope of the duty and different remedies provided for the breach thereof in the various legal systems.
